Job description

Job Summary

You will be responsible for carrying out site visits and write a report to communicate existing and potential defects of the visited project. Typically, site visits are 3 hours long, and in a standard week you will be expected to carry out up to 5 site visits per week with provision of sufficient office time for admin and report writing. The CSI~QA administrative team will provide you with support and in discussion with yourself, arrange visits a minimum of 4 weeks in advance, grouping projects based on location to minimise traveling. On report writing days you will be required to work from home and will be provided with appropriate equipment including a company laptop and phone. You will be responsible for generating a report documenting areas where quality or technical specifications do not meet the required standard, evidencing this by providing a picture, a short description and supporting documentation. You will be provided with a tablet and license to construction specific software to facilitate this efficiently on site. Support with software is available from CSI~QA administrative team.

1. Conducting site visits
2. Expectation of 5 visits per week
3. Report Writing to communicate existing and potential defects.
4. Review client responses to reported defects to ensure they meet Building Regulations & NHBC Standards.
